

- 1) 14:33 – Jesus took 3 disciples with him to pray privately in the garden (2 of them – James and John – said in Mark 10:39 they could drink of the same cup as Christ)
- 2) 14:32-33 – Jesus told those disciples 3 things (2 requests and 1 statement)
- 3) 14:36 – Jesus prayed to His Father 3 things (2 statements and 1 request)
- 4) 14:39 – Jesus left the 3 disciples 3 times to pray privately (which means Jesus asked his Father 3 times for the cup to be taken away from Him)
- 5) 14:41-42 – Jesus ends this time in the garden with 7 statements (not 3, but also interesting)
- 6) 14:43 – 3 groups band together to send a delegation to Jesus (the Chief Priests, Teachers of the Law, and the Elders)
- 7) 14:58 – False witnesses repeat Jesus having said, “I will destroy this man-made temple and in **three** days will build another, not made by man”
- 8) 14:60-62 – 3 questions are asked of Jesus by the High Priest (and Jesus gives 2 responses)
- 9) 14:66-70 – Peter disowns Jesus 3 times (2 times in front of the servant girl)
- 10) 14:66-72 – Peter remembered the words Jesus spoke to him: “**Before the rooster crows twice you will disown me three times.**”
- 11) 15:9-14 – Pilate asks the crowd 3 questions – they reply two times: “Crucify Him”
- 12) 15:25 – It was the 3rd hour when Jesus was crucified
- 13) 15:27 – 3 were crucified (Jesus and 2 robbers, one on each side of Him)
- 14) 15:29 – Passerby’s hurled insults: “So! You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in **three** days, come down from the cross and save yourself!” (as an aside: remember Jesus’ actual prediction was that if *they* destroyed the temple he would raise it in three days)
- 15) 15:34 – Jesus utters his last sentence: **Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?** Notice 3 words, one of them repeated twice.
- 16) 15:40 – 3 women are mentioned watching the crucifixion (Mary, Mary, and Salome)
- 17) 16:1 – Those same 3 women later come to the tomb where they were met by an angel (who incidentally made another 7 statements)
- 18) 16:9 – Jesus rose on the 3rd day
- 19) 16:9-12 – In the morning of his resurrection Jesus appeared to 3 people: first to Mary and then to 2 disciples in the country.
